

COURSE NUMBERING

The course numbering system is designed to indicate the relative academic level of courses in this manner:

000–099	Remedial or developmental courses
100–299, 1000–	Undergraduate, lower-division, baccalaureate level courses
2999	
300–499, 3000–	Undergraduate, upper-division, baccalaureate level courses
4999	
500–799, 5000–	Graduate level, normally indicating first through third year beyond baccalaureate
7999	
800–999, 8000–	Postgraduate level, indicating fourth year beyond baccalaureate
9999
