

WITHDRAWAL

Students departing the university for longer than one academic year (3 consecutive terms, e.g., fall, spring, summer) will be required to follow the current catalog at the time of their readmission.

Official Withdrawals (p. 1)

Students who wish to officially withdraw from the university must submit the official withdrawal form (https://biola.formstack.com/forms/biola_withdrawal_form2/). Unofficial Withdrawals (p. 1)

Students who stop attending class are considered unofficially withdrawn. Unofficial withdrawals receive no tuition refund and are given UW grades for their courses.

Medical Withdrawals (p. 1)

Students who are withdrawing for health reasons and wish to apply for a medical withdrawal may do so by submitting the official withdrawal form (https://biola.formstack.com/forms/biola_withdrawal_form2).
