

TYPICAL COSTS

The combination of tuition, fees and associated expenses at Biola University requires students to carefully calculate their financial resources and costs. The following estimated student budgets reflect the typical costs to full-time students for the 2025–26 academic year (nine months) in several of Biola’s academic programs.
