Admission Requirements

All students seeking a Theatre Minor (<https://www.biola.edu/degrees/u/theatre-minor/>) must demonstrate theatrical background and the strengths in performance and/or composition necessary for successful completion of the stated curriculum. Admission into Biola University does not guarantee admission into the Conservatory as a Theatre Minor. A student will be admitted to the Conservatory of Music after:

1. Meeting requirements for University admission.
2. Completing a Conservatory application with the required number of references.
3. Completing a Conservatory audition.
